■ A tactile and elegant design

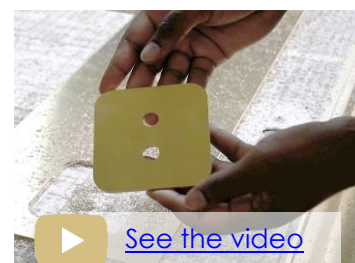

The innovative, carefully designed shapes offer ease of use and a unique and satisfying tactile experience. The contrast between the brushed brass finish of the plate and the shiny black base of the toggle accentuates the elegant lines of the switch.

Labeled *Origine France Garantie*, the range is available in several functions: sockets, RJ sockets, USB ...
