




## nparalleled expertise, endless potential for customisation

These techniques can be applied to produce any number of bespoke finishes, from the most subtle to the most extravagant, with complex shapes, rare metals, precious stones and any motifs available on request, achieving an unprecedented level of detail. Each Meljac X Tournaire Décor switch is an eye-catching work of art that perfectly captures the spirit of its surroundings.

### ringing the art of jewellery to interiors

Three "high jewellery" switch models have been created, each drawing on the respective expertise of Tournaire and Meliac. Adorned with more than 10 carats of diamonds for the "Alchimie" model, 5 carats of sapphires for the "Bas" relief" model and 3 carats of sapphires and I carat of diamonds for the "Engrenages" model, these are the most exquisite switches in the world, bringing a uniquely dazzling touch to the most prestigious interiors.
