The new decorative brass plates, developed for Béhar Sécurité's Luce series, are machined by Meljac and available in the 29 finishes in its colour chart. Each plate is polished, brushed, patinated and bead-blasted, giving architects and designers the possibility of creating visual continuity between emergency lighting and Meljac's switches, sockets, thermostats and other products.

The plates, available in a round or square format (Classique or Solaris collections), provide a coherent decorative signature that is visible in every detail.



This new design is compatible with all emergency lighting (exit signs and anti-panic units) and signage, and maintains the quality and regulatory compliance that Béhar Sécurité is known for.

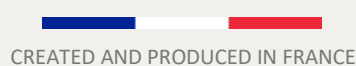

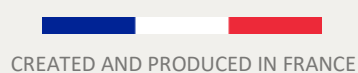
